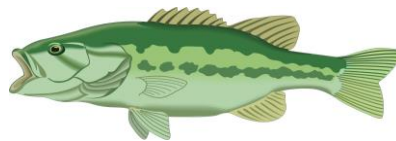

Bring coolers or containers. For the Channel Catfish and Largemouth Bass, 5-gallon pails per 25 fish work best because these fish tend to puncture a hole through their bags.
